

Resolution No. 283

ESTABLISHING SPECIAL METER ACCESS CHARGE

WHEREAS, at times it is impossible for District employees to access meter boxes for meter reading and repair, and

WHEREAS, after written notification some property owners continue to restrict access to meter boxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Water Commissioners of Lake Forest Park Water District, King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That effective with the signing of this Resolution, that meters must be accessible at all times for reading and repairs.
2. If the meter is inaccessible due to debris or parked vehicles of any type located over the meter box, the meter reading will be estimated.
3. In the event of vegetation preventing access to the meter box, the property owner shall be assessed a special meter access charge, at a minimum of \$65 per hour, to make the meter accessible until all vegetation and debris are removed. This charge will be for each instance that the meter is determined to be inaccessible for meter reading or repair.
